**Our reduced rate is for children needing only 30 minutes or less of care before and after school. If your child(ren) attend the program longer than 30 minutes, you will be charged the full rate.

Youth Development

Children who regularly attend the Before & After School Programs are offered 30 of the 40 "Positive Youth Development Assets" as identified through national research by the Search Institute. Here is a partial list:

Caring School Climate: Program provides a caring, encouraging environment.

Bonding to School: Young person grows to care about his or her school.

Creative Activities: Young person spends three or more hours per week in lesson or practice in music, theater and other arts.

Reading for Pleasure: Young person reads for pleasure three or more hours per week.

Peaceful Conflict Resolution: Young person seeks to resolve conflict non-violently.

Honesty: Young person tells the truth even when it is not easy.

Self-Esteem: Young person reports having a high self-esteem.

Other Adult Relationships: Young person receives support from three or more non-parent adults.
